

CONSTITUTION OF THE
ART HISTORY GRADUATE ASSOCIATION (AGHA)

Article I. Purpose.

This organization will foster communication and cooperation between those students who are pursuing advanced degrees in the field of art history. In addition to connecting students, the organization will establish a more concrete channel of communication between the students and the art history faculty. AGHA will facilitate annual lectures and should organize bi-annual workshops on professional development to prepare its members for entry into the field.

Article II. Organization

Section 1: The name of this organization shall be: Art History Graduate Association.

Section 2: All registered graduate students pursuing degrees in art history are eligible to be voting members of this organization.

Section 3: The position of faculty liaison shall be filled by a member of the Art History Faculty, chosen by a majority vote of the members and the approval of the Director of Graduate Studies.

Section 4: The officers of this organization shall be as follows:

A. President, Vice-President, Secretary-Treasurer and 2 Representatives who will attend meetings of the Graduate Studies Student Association (GSSA), our umbrella association.

B. The President, Vice President, and Secretary-Treasurer will be elected by the general membership during the spring semester, to serve for the following academic year. Representatives shall be elected in the fall to serve for the current academic year.

Section 5: Membership dues shall be assessed by a majority vote.

Section 6: A minimum of two meetings shall be held during each semester of the academic year. Other meetings may be called as necessary.

Article III. Amendments

This constitution may be amended by a majority vote of the members.
